**Renovare (to make new)**

This September, the Sioux Falls area will be hosting an ecumenical event put on by the Sioux Falls Area Spiritual Formation Conference. This event is designed to assist all who participate in spiritual growth and formation and to equip them with the needed tools in helping others to do the same.

This Sunday's Gospel is a good example of our need to "be made new". Jesus tells the parable of the man who had an incredibly large harvest. The man must have been a great farmer and the weather must have been favorable – the very things all of us hope for in our own lives. But when the man decides to build bigger barns to store the harvest and then take it easy for a while, God calls him a fool! How many of us spend time wishing we could win the lottery, get a big inheritance or a fat raise and promotion and work? We envision being able to "eat, drink and be merry". Our culture is all about financial and material success so if we finally attained that goal, would we expect to be called a fool? Most of us would revel in our good fortune and call everyone we know to let them know how great life is. Would we do the same thing if we were abundantly blessed in a non-material way? If God granted a favorable answer to prayer, would we "revel in our good fortune and call everyone we know"? Probably not.

For me, it's one more example of how different our ways are from God's ways. It's not that wealth is evil, but our striving for it while ignoring the basics of life (vocation, family, faith) can be harmful. God seems to be telling us that if we have the blessings of abundance, we have them for the sole purpose of sharing with others. It's no wonder there is so much anxiety, tension, and confusion in our culture. *Renovare* seeks to assist each of us in "making things new" in our own lives by helping us properly prioritize. As we become more spiritually disciplined, our outlook eventually comes to be a little more like God's. Attending this conference will help you learn the essentials of living a vibrant Christian life.
