WHAT DO YOU KNOW, FR. JOE?

I welcome Seminarian John Iverson to our parish. He will be with us through the months of June and July.

It is with great excitement that we are able to schedule the **groundbreaking and blessing of our new building site**. We have been working on this project for quite some time. I am delighted that so many parishioners have already been involved in the designing and planning of this building. It is impressive that quite a bit of the materials will be donated and that a significant amount of the labor will come from our parishioners. May God bless all those who have already taken part in this work of love as well as all those who will soon help.

At this time, we have 67% (502 families out of 745 registered) of our parishioners who have made a pledge (either a pledge of money or prayer) for our project. That leaves 243 families yet to participate. By all standards this figure is very good, but I do not think that we should be satisfied with this figure. As this new building will serve many different needs in our parish (parish hall, youth room, religious education classrooms, school classrooms, gymnasium and kitchen) there is something in here for everyone. **Our goal is 100% participation.** If you can't give financially, then consider pledging to pray everyday for our project. Prayers are always an acceptable way of giving. If you can give even five dollars a week (give up one pop a day), it really adds up. Our goal as a parish should be that we all are able to say the day our new addition opens, **"Look what all of did together as a community, with God's help!"**



Meet our Seminarian, John Iverson

I was born in Brookings in late 1950 and graduated from high school there in 1969. I have one younger brother, five older brothers and three older sisters. I graduated from SDSU in the spring of 1973. That fall, I began teaching middle school science in the Brookings School System. In 1995, I

switched to 8th grade Math and Algebra. I was able to retire in 2006. A vocation had been in the back of my mind for a number of years, so I decided to pursue this calling.

I have completed one year at Blessed John XXIII National Seminary in Weston, MA, just a few miles from Boston. This seminary was founded especially for older vocations. Many fine priests have been formed here, including our own Bishop Swain and Fr. Ed Anderson. I hope to be ordained in 2013.
